## Spring Clean-Up

## Article VII

***Property to be Maintained. Each Lot at all times shall be kept in a clean, sightly, and wholesome condition. No trash, litter, junk, boxes, containers, bottles, cans, implements, machinery, lumber, or other building materials shall be permitted to remain exposed upon any Lots so that same are visible from any neighboring Lot or street, except as necessary during the period of construction. Owners shall maintain the exterior appearance of any residential structure or unit located on their Lot including, by way of example and not limitation, the repair of damaged windows, siding or roof, repair of exterior surfaces, and repainting of unsightly painted surfaces.***

## CURRENT LAKE RULES

- No parties at this time. We are following Eagle County Health Department guidelines
- Maintain social distancing guidelines; no groups over 10
- No glass anywhere around the lake
- No non-resident parking inside the gate, so don't use your card to let others inside. Guests are to park at the preschool
- No unlocked boats
- No off-leash dogs in the park area from the gate to the Mid Valley Metro gate and no dogs on the beach

Also remember that our park is for residents and their ACCOMPANIED guests only. Do not tell non-resident friends that they can come without you. Our security WILL tell them to leave. We don't pay them to be passivists. Thank you!

## Seasonal Boat Storage at Lake

Bathrooms will open for the season soon. At this time we allow boats to be stored at the lake. Boats must be locked to the rails when not in use. Unlocked boats will be removed and a release fee will be assessed.

You can register now. Last year's stickers must be re-registered before leaving the boat at the lake. Please contact Gina for details and rules. A \$25 annual registration fee is charged for the first boat, and \$10 for each additional boat.
