

## **Rules for Blue Lake and Adjacent Recreation Area**

The lake and surrounding area is private property. It has been designated a multi-use recreation area, with the lake to be used specifically for fishing, swimming and light boating. Only Blue Lake homeowners and their accompanied guests are allowed to use the lake and facilities.

Hours of use for general activities shall be sunrise to sunset.

To provide everyone with the most benefit and safety while at the lake, the Board of Directors has adopted the following rules:

### **GENERAL RULES**

1. Only Blue Lake Homeowners and accompanied guests may use the lake and surrounding area.
2. Park in designated parking areas only. No overnight parking allowed.
3. Children under the age of eight (8) must be supervised by an adult.
4. Dogs must be leashed at all times on the south side of the lake. Dogs are not allowed in the water in the designated swimming area. Owners must pick up all droppings.
5. Amplified music will point toward the highway and at a reasonable volume.
6. No glass containers.
7. Do not leave trash.
8. Parties and music will end at dusk.
9. A \$300 damage deposit for large parties or when erecting tents is required.

### **SWIMMING**

Swim at your own risk. No life guards on duty.

### **BOATING**

1. Boats cannot be over eighteen (18') feet long.
2. No motors allowed. NO remote controlled boats. Only hand or wind power..
3. Boaters may not have any petroleum products on board.
4. Boaters must comply with all state regulations regarding boating, including life vests and safety equipment.
5. No boats or windsurfers in the designated swimming area.

### **FISHING**

1. Catch & release rules is for those twelve (12) years old and above.
2. Only artificial lures or flies are to be used.
3. Bag limit for those 12 years of age and younger is two fish of any size per day.
4. No fishing on the south side of the lake.

### **PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES \***

1. No ice skating, ice fishing, ice walking or sledding.

2. No scuba diving.
3. No hunting or discharge of firearms.
4. No camping or campfires outside of provided grills.
5. No activity of any kind on Blue Pond.

\* Certain activities may be allowed with permission from the Board of Directors, when required for lake research, maintenance, or public safety.

**The fishing season at Blue Lake begins May 1<sup>st</sup> and ends November 1<sup>st</sup>.**
